WHAT IS THIRD PERSON POV?

Third person point of view (POV) allows you to write as the narrator of the story.

As a

narrator, you describe what the characters do and what happens to them.

There are 3 types of third person POV:

Omniscient

The narrator knows everything about all characters,
their feelings and what they are thinking

"Jake knew he should ask her to stay, but had other worried in his mind. Jackie would no longer wait for him to makeup his mind. Jake saw in dismay as she walked away."

Limited omniscient

Narrator sticks more closely to one particular character

"Jackie felt hurt, she thought of staying, but walked towards the bus"

Objective

Neutral, does not know what characters are thinking or feeling

"Jackie walked away from Jake and got on the bus"

Here are some third-person pronouns:

He, him, his, himself, she, her, hers, herself, it, its, itself, they, them, their, theirs, and themselves.
