WHAT IS A SIMILE?

Simile is when you compare two or more things using "like" or "as".

These are the most common, but can also use "as if" and "than."

Here are some examples of **similes**:



He got **as red as** a tomato



He could swim **like** a fish



They crept up to the house,
as quiet as a mouse

Remember! Keep in mind what the comparison in similes are saying. If someone can "swim like a fish", what does that say about them? Are they a *great* swimmer or a *bad* swimmer?
