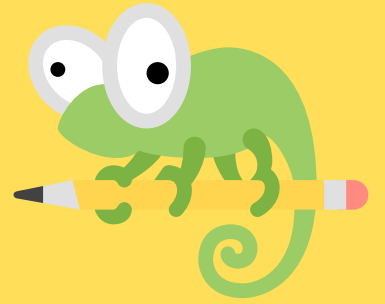


Quick Guide: How to write a Haiku!

- A Haiku is 3 lines
- The lines must follow the following amount of syllables: 5, 7, 5

Here is an example:

Curious Alice
Follows a hopping rabbit.
Adventure awaits.

Broken down into syllables:

Cu-ri-ous A-lice [5]

Fol-lows a hop-ping rab-bit. [7]

Ad-ven-ture a-waits. [5]
