The City is currently reviewing an application to redevelop the Escondido Country Club and golf course. As part of the process, the City created a e-newsletter to provide timely and informative news about the project.

WHAT'S GOING ON RIGHT NOW

As you know, a draft Environmental Impact Report (DEIR) was prepared to identify the existing activities and uses at the Project site and evaluate how future conditions might change if the proposed Project is built. On June 28, 2017 a [Notice of Availability](#) was issued for the DEIR for the proposed Project that set a 45-day public comment period that was to end on August 11, 2017. **The City of Escondido is extending the public comment period for the DEIR by seven (7) days for a total of 52 days.** Comments on the DEIR will now be accepted through Friday, August 18, 2017 until 11:59 P.M. PST. The DEIR will continue to be available for review on the City's website (<https://www.escondido.org/ecc-deir.aspx>), at the Escondido Public Library (239 S. Kalmia Street) and Escondido City Hall Planning Division (201 N. Broadway).
